The School's annual Commencement Ceremony and Reception will be held on Friday, May 20, 2011 to honor August 2010, December 2010 and May 2011 graduates of the Bachelor of Arts in Liberal Studies, Master of Arts in Liberal Studies, Doctor of Liberal Studies, and Master of Professional Studies degree programs.

- Ceremony: 3:30 p.m., <u>Healy Lawn</u> (Rain Location <u>McDonough Arena</u>)
- Reception: 5:00 p.m., <u>Leo J. O'Donovan Dining Hall</u>

No tickets will be required, but students must <u>RSVP</u> with an approximate number of guests to help us plan for the reception following the event.

Please review the Graduation Application and Clearance Process to ensure you are eligible and cleared to participate.

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# **Commencement Ceremony Check-in Procedures**

Students should report to the second floor of White Gravenor by 2:00 p.m. for official check-in and lineup by program. The formal procession onto the Lawn will begin promptly at 3:15 p.m. Information concerning the check-in and lineup location will be provided by e-mail to those graduates who have RSVP'd to walk at commencement.

All students will receive a packet of announcements through their respective home departments prior to graduation. If you would like to order personalized announcements, you may do so at <a href="https://www.Jostens.com">www.Jostens.com</a>.

Participating faculty members should arrive to the second floor of White Gravenor by 2:00 p.m. for official check-in and lineup. Information concerning the check-in and lineup location will be provided by e-mail to faculty who have RSVP'd for commencement.

Students and Faculty: Please note that you will be responsible for carrying all of the items you bring with you on graduation day. Purses/bags will not be allowed in the procession. Please leave all cameras, purses, wallets, etc with your family/friends before you arrive to sign-in.

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# **Eligibility for Graduation, Clearance and Financial Holds**

Please review the Graduation Application and Clearance Process to ensure you are eligible and cleared to participate.

The academic clearance process for graduation can be completed only after all grades have been submitted and recorded. Students who do not have all grades recorded cannot be cleared. Therefore, we ask all graduating students to notify their instructors of their intent to graduate and to encourage their instructors to post grades in a timely manner. Students may not graduate with outstanding incompletes on their record. International students should contact the Office of International Programs at (202) 687-5867 to update their status.

All students are encouraged to review their <u>transcripts</u> with their academic departments as they prepare for graduation to ensure that everything is in order.

\*\*Please note: BALS and MPS students who are within 6 credits of completing their coursework in the up-coming summer semester may choose to walk in the Commencement Ceremony. MALS and DLS students must have completed all required coursework and have received thesis approval from their academic advisor to walk in the Ceremony. In very rare cases, final thesis review and approval from the Dean's Office might occur after Commencement. Only the names of students expected to complete their degrees by the end of the current spring semester (and who earned their degrees in the prior year's fall and summer semesters) will appear in the annual Commencement Book. For example, the names of students graduating in summer 2011 will appear in the following year's 2011-2012 Commencement Book.

The University cannot distribute diplomas or official transcripts to students with financial obligations in excess of \$100. It is imperative that students resolve all financial obligations prior to graduation through the Office of Student Accounts, located on the lower level of White Gravenor.

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# **Commencement Parking**

In the event of rain, the School of Continuing Studies will conduct the graduation ceremony in the Georgetown University McDonough Arena. Please note that in the event of rain, there will be no restrictions to the number of guests you may invite to the Commencement Ceremony or Reception.

While every effort is made to ensure complete accuracy within the Commencement Book, please note that appearing in it does not guarantee degree conferral, nor does the act of walking in the Commencement Ceremony. Degrees are awarded and posted on transcripts only after all requirements have been successfully completed and certified by the Office of Academic Affairs & Compliance.

If there are extra copies of the 2011 Commencement Program Book after the ceremony, we will make them available on a first-come, first-served basis. An email will go out with specifics once we know if there are extras.

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# **Request Special Needs for Commencement Day**

Sign interpreters will be present at the ceremony. If students or friends/family have other special needs to help them enjoy the ceremony, please let us know by Friday, May 6, 2010, in an e-mail to scsgrad@georgetown.edu. We will do our best to accommodate all special needs.

For those of you who requested wheelchair rental on graduation day, please have your family member bring a photo ID and major credit card (to hold only, it will not be charged unless it is not returned) to the main university gates (37th and O street) when they arrive to pick up the wheelchair. There will be ushers assigned to assist wheelchair guests in their rental, as well as getting to the reserved wheelchair seating. Each wheelchair guest may bring one additional guest into this section to sit with them during the ceremony.

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#### **Instructions for Ordering Your Cap and Gown for Students**

To participate in the commencement ceremony, students must be dressed in the correct academic attire. Students are responsible for ordering their own commencement regalia from the Georgetown Bookstore. Cap and gown rental is not offered for students.

Students may purchase and pick-up gowns at the bookstore the week of Commencement.

In person pickup dates:

Graduating students may also purchase regalia by calling the bookstore catalog department at 1-800-548-5452. Calling this number will also allow you to request Fed Ex delivery of your regalia.

The hood for the Master of Arts in Liberal Studies degree is white. The hood for the Master of Professional Studies degree is peacock blue.

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# **Instructions for Ordering Your Cap and Gown for Faculty**

Participating faculty members must wear academic regalia to the ceremony.

<u>RSVP</u> here for the commencement week activities by March 28, 2011, and to provide rental information for your commencement regalia. Regalia rental is provided by the School of Continuing Studies at no cost to faculty.

Faculty may also purchase custom made Regalia at their own cost (\$420.95 for Doctoral gown, hood, tam, tassel and \$295.95 for Masters). 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# **Commencement Reception**

The Commencement Ceremony will be followed by a Commencement Reception at Georgetown University <u>Leo O'Donovan Dining Hall</u>at 5:00 p.m. Students may invite all commencement guests to this reception. Students can pick up their diplomas before or during the reception in <u>McShain Large</u> in McCarthy Hall directly across from the Leo O'Donovan Dining Hall.

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
