

Tuition Scholarship Application Form

The Paralegal Studies Program will award four (4) \$1,000.00 partial scholarships to currently admitted students of the 2014 Summer Intensive Program. Each scholarship is a tuition credit that covers a portion of the tuition for the 2014 Summer Intensive Paralegal Studies Program. The scholarship is applicable only to the 2014 Summer Intensive Program.

Scholarship Eligibility

You are eligible to apply for the scholarship if you have been admitted to the 2014 Summer Intensive Paralegal Studies Program at Georgetown University. No other eligibility requirements apply. A student may receive no more than one scholarship.

You must submit the following documentation for consideration:

- Completed Tuition Scholarship Application Form (this form).
- Written response to one application question (see below).
