

## PETITION FOR NON-WESTERN STUDIES CREDIT

Each student in the Bachelor of Arts in Liberal Studies program must complete 6 credits (2 courses) in courses that focus on non-Western studies. The B.A.L.S. program offers several courses that satisfy this requirement, but a student also can use this form to petition for a transfer course taken at another college, or a course taken elsewhere at Georgetown, to apply to the non-Western studies requirement.
