Georgetown University is able to offer the *Executive Master's Program in Program & Portfolio Management* to residents in ALL states* EXCEPT the following:

- Delaware

- Minnesota
- Oregon

*This program can also be offered to residents of the District of Columbia and Puerto Rico.

Please check back regularly; this list will be updated as we receive approval to offer this program in additional states.

We are currently only able to accept international students who are residing in the following countries and provinces: Brazil; Germany; Hong Kong; Mexico; Nigeria; Qatar; Singapore; South Korea; United Kingdom; Ontario, Canada; Quebec, Canada; or Alberta, Canada.

Visa support is offered for the two in-person residencies that are required to complete the Executive Master of Professional Studies in Program & Portfolio Management program.

Degrees conferred by Georgetown University are recognized in the United States and may be recognized in other countries. Degrees and certificates conferred by Georgetown University are not officially recognized by Mexico. All international students are encouraged to research the policies pertaining to degree recognition in their home country prior to enrolling in a Georgetown program.
