The USO and Georgetown University have partnered to deliver "A Certificate in Franchise Venture Planning." This six-day course is an exciting new opportunity for wounded, ill and injured service members, as well as their spouses or caregivers, and spouses of the fallen who want to:

- Learn more about small business and franchise management.
- Build confidence in their ability to properly navigate prospective franchise opportunities.
- Make informed decisions to successfully transition toward a career in franchise and/or small business ownership.

Upon satisfactory completion of the course, participants will earn a certificate in Franchise Venture Planning from Georgetown University!

## **Eligibility Criteria:**

- Post-9/11 wounded, ill or injured service member, either still on Active Duty, or within 18 months of a medical separation (provide DD214). Spouses/caregivers of such individuals, and families of the fallen are also eligible to participate.
- Completed waiver form and short registration essay.
- No immediate family members employed by Georgetown University or the USO.
