

Osher Reentry Scholarship Application

Scholarship Criteria

The Osher Reentry Scholarship of up to \$5,000 is awarded to students earning their first bachelor's degree in the Bachelor of Arts in Liberal Studies program at Georgetown University after an interruption in their postsecondary study. To be eligible, an applicant must:

- have experienced a cumulative gap in education of five or more years
- anticipate workforce participation for a significant period of time after graduation
- demonstrate financial need
- show academic promise and commitment to completing the degree

How to Apply

To apply for the Osher Reentry Scholarship, you must

- Submit a complete admissions application to the B.A.L.S. program by the deadline
- Complete and submit this scholarship application by the deadline
- Submit a FAFSA to the federal government and request that a Student Aid Report be sent to Georgetown University (code 001445) by the deadline

Incomplete applications and applications submitted after the deadline will not be considered for the scholarship. Recipients will be notified of their scholarships at the time of admission.

In addition to the B.A.L.S. admission application, the following items are required:

- A current resume
- A 300-word essay that describes your commitment to postsecondary education, the circumstances of the earlier interruption(s) to your postsecondary education and your return to study, and your career plans after graduation.
