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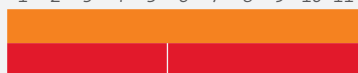

## Fundamental/Intro Courses

*(Take one class per session; earn up to six credits)*

## Summer Honors Intensive

*(Take two classes per session; earn up to 12 credits)*

Highly motivated high school students who are seeking a rigorous academic experience are encouraged to take two courses per session. Over the course of the summer, you will have the opportunity to attend classes alongside undergraduate students, study a broad range of subjects, and get ahead on your college studies.
