Veterans Benefits – Eligible Noncredit Programs

The following certificate programs are eligible for funding through the Department of Veterans Affairs under the Post-9/11 GI Bill (Chapter 33), Montgomery GI Bill (Chapter 30), and Vocational Rehabilitation (Chapter 31) programs. Only courses required for completion of the certificate can be certified to the VA, and only on-campus certificate programs are eligible for funding. Students using VA benefits cannot combine online & on-campus classes for a certificate.
